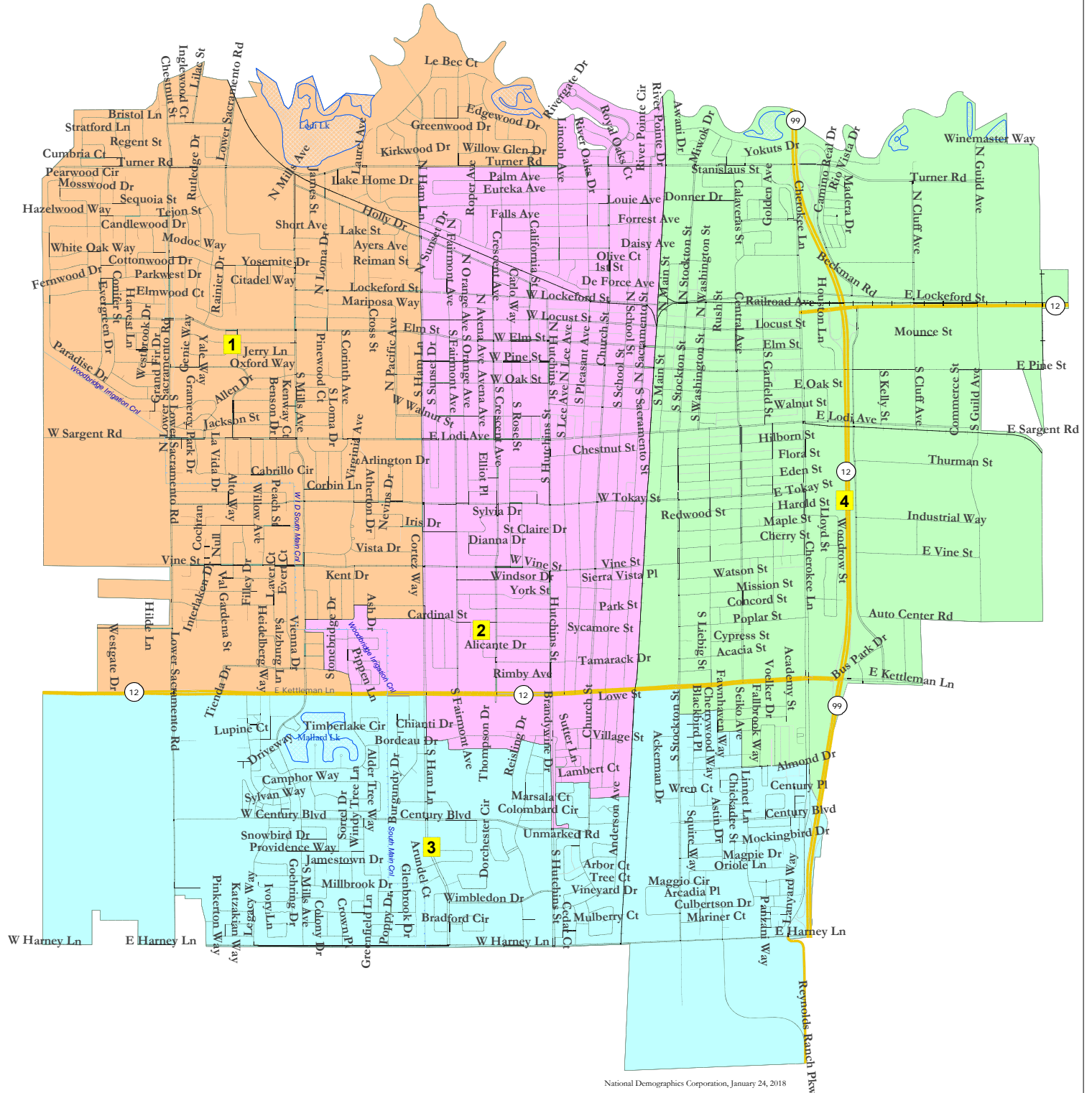


City of Lodi 2018 Districting
